### Sculpture Donated to Anderson Farm Museum

The Anderson Farm Museum Heritage Society and Tyler Fauvelle, a sculptor based in Lively, Ontario, are pleased to announce that “*Yesterday’s Morning*”, an artist’s proof of a limited edition bronze, will be donated to the Anderson Farm Museum on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

“...Anderson Farm was one of the largest dairies in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, inspiring me to create this work during my sculpture demonstration at the AFMHS’s 2012 Annual Fall Fair”, said Fauvelle. He added: “...Women have always carried a heavy workload on the farm, and this sculpture shows years of work, imprinted in the dairy maid’s face and posture. Although many of yesterday’s ways are gone, modern farms still demand long hours of hard work.”

Tyler Fauvelle created three 7 ft. bronze sculptures for the 2012 Timmins Centennial, and recently completed “*We See Thee Rise*”, a montage of heroes of the War of 1812.

“*Yesterday’s Morning*” will be displayed at the Anderson Farm Museum, which features museum displays & exhibits, heritage events, festivals, fairs, workshops and demonstrations. The Anderson Farm Museum Heritage Society works to preserve and develop Anderson Farm as a vital City of Greater Sudbury heritage site, and offers many free community events, such as the ‘Rock the Farm’ Concerts/Farmers’ Market summer series, and the popular Annual Fall Fair.
