At the Anderson Farm Museum, your students will have the chance to participate in a curriculum-based, interactive day with the opportunity to:

- Tour a century-old farmhouse, a historic dairy barn and milkhouse to learn about pioneer living and work on an early twentieth century dairy farm;
- Milk Northern Maple, a life-sized interactive dairy cow model, and learn about milk production on early farms up to the present day; and
- Participate in turn of the century crafts and games, making a lot of fun with very little!
